

## General vaccination and deworming protocol for dogs & cats

### Deworming:

Starting ----- At the age of 15 days.  
Up to 3 months age----- Every 15 day interval.  
From 3 months age-----One month interval.  
6 Months onwards----- Every 3 month's interval.

### Dog Vaccinations:

1. KC Primary ---- At the age of 1 month  
Then----- Annual  
\*72 hrs prior to boarding in non vaccinated dog
2. DHPPi +L Primary-----At age of 6 to 8 weeks  
1st Booster---- after 1 month  
2nd Booster---after 1 month of 1<sup>st</sup> booster  
Then-----Annual
3. Corona Primary-----At the age of 8 weeks age  
Booster-----after 1 month  
Then-----Annual
4. Rabies Primary -----At age of 3 months  
Booster----- after 1 month  
Then-----Annual

### Cat Vaccinations:

PCHR Primary -----At 3 month's age  
Booster-----after 1 month  
Then -----Annual

### NOTE: -

1. Vaccination schedule is based on manufacturer's recommendations.
2. Pets found unfit/sick on veterinary examination will not be vaccinated.
3. Pets bought from pet shops/unknown sources should be screened prior to vaccinations for infectious diseases through laboratory card tests and hematological/biochemical blood examination.
4. It is advisable to vaccinate pets in morning hours.
5. Some pets can develop anaphylactic reactions. Better wait at the reception for one hour post vaccination.
6. Pets can have loose stools, vomiting, loss of appetite and fever after vaccinations.
7. Pets with a history of epilepsy should be closely monitored after vaccinations.
